

GUIDELINES
BLUE WATER PLEASURE HORSE ASSOCIATION
SCHOLARSHIP

- I. The Scholarship
 - a. The amount awarded per recipient and number of scholarships in any given year is not to exceed \$500.00 unless deemed necessary by Blue Water Board of Directors.
 - b. Recipient will be announced at the BWPHA Awards Banquet.
 - c. If a recipient is awarded a scholarship, they must enroll within two (2) consecutive enrollment periods after high school graduation, or will forfeit the award.
 - d. Upon notification of enrollment, the recipient's check in the amount awarded will be issued upon receipt of payment over \$500.00 to college or higher education.
 - e. All information will be held in strictest confidence by the Selection Committee.
 - f. Application deadline: September 15 of the year applicant is applying.

- II. Selection Process for Committee
 - a. Financing will consist of \$500.00 from the Association sponsored shows to be put into the scholarship fund account with any shortage to be made up from the General Fund.
 - b. Scores to be based on a 100 point scale:
 - 1. Grade Point: 25%
 - 2. Future Plans: 25%
 - 3. All horse related activities: 30%
 - 4. Extracurricular: 15%

- III. Selection Process
 - a. The applicant must be a member in good standing for the past (2) consecutive years.
 - b. The applicant must participate, in the year of the application, at seven (7) show dates and verify their participation by the signature of the adult show delegate on the show bill for that date. **(Double point shows count only as one show.)**
 - c. Scholarship will be awarded only once to an applicant.
 - d. Applicant must submit in their behalf, one (1) letter of recommendation from a teacher or counselor.

- e. A transcript, showing the most recent cumulative grade point average; based on a 4.0 scale, must accompany the application.
- f. An applicant shall NOT have reached their nineteenth birthday by January 1 of the year in which they apply for the scholarship. Applicant must be between the ages of 16-18 years old.
- g. The applicant should list all horse activities and involvement.
- h. Applicant should list all extracurricular activities including, but not limited to, student government, 4-H, FFA, sports, and community service.
- i. Applicant should list any and all offices held in organizations of which he/she has been a member.
- j. Applicant should list all honors or awards received to date.
- k. Applicant should describe all employment activities.
- l. Applicant should define his/her future goals, including involvement with horses. The essay should be 2 pages, doubled spaced, 12 font, with one inch margins.
- m. Applicant should list all special circumstances which may affect committee's decision.
- n. All applications MUST be legible.
- o. All applicants must volunteer at one association show. Applicant should list the job done and hours worked and have the adult delegate verify by signing the enclosed sheet.
